In general, NYATCP Board members seek to support the organization’s mission which is to promote and advocate for the establishment, funding, and enhancement of New York’s treatment courts. Board members advance the organization’s mission through training events, technical assistance, and mutual support. Specifically, Board members are expected to serve on at least two committees, to assist in monitoring and managing the organization’s financial resources, to advance the use of evidence-based practices in New York’s treatment courts, and to recruit new Board members

**\*\*Special Advisor** In 2018, The Board amended its Bylaws to include an “Advisory Council”. The Board of Directors sought to tap the expertise and experience of treatment court professionals who could provide valuable counsel on special projects. Such projects might encompass a diverse array of topics and necessitate specialized expertise, e.g., testifying at public hearings that address matters germane to treatment courts, conducting research on pending bills in the New York legislature, analysis of newly enacted laws affecting treatment courts, assessing the impact of new regulations affecting the treatment of substance use or mental health disorders.
